The 40th annual meeting of the Alliance for Historic Landscape Preservation—along with the extraordinary ecological and cultural setting of Tucson, Arizona—will provide a venue for lively and thoughtful discussions about cultural landscapes and their conservation. Students are especially encouraged to submit presentation proposals that address expressions of Spanish and Mexican culture and heritage, Native American heritage and places of importance to other indigenous peoples, cattle ranching and other forms of food production and land management, expressions of mid-century modernism, and topics concerning industries of extraction, tourism, and urban renewal.

Scholarship Details:

Up to two student scholarships are available to attend and present research at the annual meeting.

One student will be invited to present his or her studies in cultural landscape conservation as part of the conference paper sessions.

One student will be invited to present his or her studies as a poster during the poster sessions of the conference program.

The total value of each scholarship includes a waiver of the conference registration fee and an award of \$1000 to offset travel expenses. Upper-level undergraduate and graduate students in any discipline related to cultural landscape conservation may apply. - Three (3) letters of recommendation from your professors or employers.

The deadline for the receipt of student scholarship applications is November 27, 2017. Selected students will be notified on or before December 15, 2017.
