STORIES OF LANDSCAPE TRANSFORMATION

The Alliance for Historic Landscape Preservation (AHLP) is pleased to announce its 2023 annual meeting theme of *Richmond on the James: Stories of Landscape Transformation* to be held in Richmond, VA. We envision the Richmond meeting as a landscape dialogue/exploration that addresses, analyzes, and critiques contemporary issues of the urban cultural landscape.

National publications rate Richmond as one of the best places to live, work, and visit. At the same time, Richmond is reconsidering the places of its often-painful past—many that are landscape-related. Our meeting program and explorations of Richmond will focus on these issues, with hopes that attendees will share how other places' dilemmas and successes resonate with Richmond and national, regional, and worldwide issues.

The AHLP invites students to participate by presenting papers or sharing summaries of their work regarding cultural landscape conservation and preservation. We welcome proposals that address topical issues in cultural landscape conservation and preservation, and especially ones that address broader conference themes such as *a) landscape legacies of suppression, enslavement, submersion, segregation and supremacy, and b) landscape treatment of disconnected/disrupted or racialized landscapes through contemporary landscape interventions, planning and design dialogues, and innovation.*

Scholarship Details:

Up to two scholarships are available to assist students in attending the annual meeting and presenting their research as part of the conference paper sessions.

The scholarship includes a waiver of the conference registration fee, and an award of \$2000 USD

to offset travel and lodging expenses. Currently-enrolled upper-level undergraduate and graduate students in any discipline related to cultural landscape conservation may apply. Additional information about the conference is available at www.ahlp.org.

- A letter addressed to the Education Committee clearly stating your interests in attending the AHLP annual meeting in Richmond;
- Your current curriculum vitae;
- A one-page abstract of your proposed conference presentation, and
- At least one letter of recommendation from a professor.

The deadline for the receipt of student scholarship applications is January 16, 2023. Selected students will be notified on or before January 27, 2023.
